### June 1-4 **Ahoy, Matey! Pirate Week**

- Campers will learn about these raiders of the high seas during Pirate Week. What was it like to be a pirate? What did they eat? How did they hunt for buried treasure? Who were the two most famous female pirates? Join us as we make our own pieces of eight and treasure maps and hunt for buried treasure. ### June 7-11 **Art and Literacy Fusion**
