1) Read three chapter books:

* you will need to answer questions from each book (see attached)

2) Summer journal : Get a spiral notebook, composition book or attach several pieces of notebook paper together to make a notebook. Once a week, write a paragraph of 3 to 5 sentences about something you did that week. Using details, tell me what you did, why it was fun or not, who you were with and where it took place. Use complete sentences with capital letters, correct punctuation and your best spelling. Please include the date on the top right hand side of your paper. I would also like to see your best handwriting!

Bring the summer journal and questions about each book back to school with you by Friday, August 13, 2010. You will receive an extra 100 in the grade book for completing the questions and journal. We will be talking about the books and doing activities related to them when you return. We will also have a test on two of the books.

3) Math - practice addition and subtraction facts up to 12.
